PART I: INTRODUCTION

1. Authority

- (a) Pursuant to section 13 of The Regional Parks Act, 2013, the Sandy Beach Lake Regional Park Authority, hereby enacts this Business Operations Bylaw.

2. Title

- (a) This Bylaw shall be known as the "EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION" of the Sandy Beach Lake Regional Park.

3. Scope

- (a) This Emergency Measures Organization Bylaw shall apply to the whole of the Sandy Beach Lake Regional Park.

4. Purpose

- (a) The purpose of the Emergency Measures Organization Bylaw shall be:
 - (i) To establish a Local Emergency Management Organization to deal with any emergency or disaster that may occur.
 - (ii) To provide for the health, protection, safety and general welfare of the persons within Sandy Beach Lake Regional Park.

PART II: DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw, the following words and terms shall have the indicated meaning, unless otherwise indicated elsewhere in the Bylaw:

BOARD means the members of the Regional Park Authority.

BUSINESS means a person or organization of persons involved in the trade of goods, services, or both to consumers.

BYLAW means the Sandy Beach Lake Regional Park Bylaws.

FISCAL YEAR means the period commencing on January 1st and ending on December 31st.

PARK means the area that is designated as Sandy Beach Lake Regional Parks Authority.

PARK AUTHORITY means the people who are, from time to time, appointed for the purpose of carrying out the management and administration of the Sandy Beach Lake Regional Park.

PARK ENTRY PERMIT means a valid and subsisting permit issued by a Park Officer to allow entry into Sandy Beach Lake Regional Park for the time specified in the permit.

PARK OFFICER means any member of the Park Authority, as well as any person employed by the Park Authority for the Administration and Management of the Park, and the enforcement of this bylaw within that area.

PERSON OR PERSONS means any individual, business, partnership, firm, corporation, or occupant of a residence.

PART III: BYLAWS

A. GENERAL

1. The Park Authority or authorized Park Officer shall establish a Local Emergency Management Organization to deal with any emergency or disaster that may occur.
2. The Park Authority shall appoint a person as a Local Emergency Coordinator; *and*
3. The Park Authority shall establish a Local Emergency Planning Committee composed of:
 - a. The Emergency Coordinator appointed in Clause 2; *and*
 - b. any other persons the Park Authority considers necessary.
4. The Emergency Coordinator is the Chairperson of the Local Emergency Planning Committee.
5. The Park Authority shall provide funding as deemed necessary and appropriate in the establishment and maintenance of the Emergency Management Organization.
6. The Park Authority may enter into agreements with other Municipalities for the purpose of jointly establishing and operating a Mutual Aid Area Emergency Management Organization.
7. This bylaw shall become effective on the date of the final reading and adoption.
